

Please understand if I am unable to respond quickly to your messages. God is busy working miracles for Ted. My job is to hold his hand and reassure him how much he is loved. To help Ted, I send out a list of specifics to pray for each day. Today we are asking God for a successful weaning from the sedation, no infections and removal of the breathing tube. We ask that you pray with us for these things.

Many of you want to visit Ted, but that is not allowed due to a high risk of infections. He will be in ICU for the foreseeable future according to his amazing medical team.

As difficult as it is for an old English teacher to say, there are truly no words to express our gratitude for the prayers and positive thoughts you are sending, plus all the help you've given us. We love and adore our church family, and you are the fulfillment of God's command to love our neighbors. Thank you so much for everything you are doing and will continue to do. I will update as I am able. Please keep those prayers coming our way.
