Activity: Thankful Tree

What You Need: Construction paper, scissors, wall tape, crayons or markers

What You Do: Decide which wall in your home you are going to put your Thankful Tree on. Remember—it will be up all month long. Create a simple trunk and branches out of brown construction paper and tape it to the wall. Then, cut out or tear leaves from green, yellow,

orange, and red construction paper. Write or draw good things God made and tape the leaves to the tree. You can add to your tree throughout November! At the end of the month, block out some special time to go through the whole tree and remember all that you were thankful for. You can even save your leaves as a memory.

(Note: If you do not have construction paper, white paper will do as well. You can color or decorate the white paper as time allows.)

Say, "Our Bible story was about how God made a really big world with lots and LOTS of good things in it. We can draw pictures of the good things God made on our leaves! When you put your leaf on the tree, I want you to say, 'Thank you for [thing's name],



God. You are so good.' God gave us all of these good things, because God is good. Who is good? God is good."

Prayer "Dear God, You are so good! You made a wonderful world for us to live in and filled it with so many good gifts for us to enjoy. We want to thank You for some of those good things. I pray we will thank You for Your goodness every day. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."

Can you believe it is November? Where has 2023 gone! I can't believe the holidays are right around the corner. They are such a fun and busy time of year and best of all, we get to celebrate the birth of our Savior.

The Diabetic Education and Support Group continues to grow, and we meet at 12:00 noon on the 2nd Tuesday of each month in the Recreation Room. This month we will meet on **November 14th**. Will, the HEB pharmacist, will bring our education program this month to discuss the new diabetic medications.

The Seniorcise chair exercise class meets on **Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday** at 10:00 am in Fellowship Hall 1. This is a DVD led chair class that offers modifications for everyone. After the exercise portion of class, we are watching short educational videos related to stroke, high blood pressure, etc. that have been well received. We have been having a great turn out and are having a lot of fun. I hope you can join us soon!

My practice continues to grow! This ministry that God has placed me in brings the greatest joy to my life. This truly is the best occupation I ever could have dreamed of! I had a total of 92 patient encounters for August, 82 encounters for September, and 75 encounters month to date for October. The greatest need I have seen over the last couple of months is gas cards, rent, and utility assistance. The population of unsheltered individuals continues to grow. There are several families including single parents that need furnishings for their apartments. If you would like to assist with that or have items to donate, please let me know. I spend a great deal of time assisting clients with navigating the system to find free or affordable providers along with other agencies to assist them with shelter, food, employment, and clothing. The emergency pantry and closet continues to serve its purpose of helping individuals when Good Samaritans and other community entities are closed. Thank you to everyone who has donated food, hygiene items, adult diapers, mosquito spray, and sunscreen. Those are always greatly appreciated.


